- To have an established culture of inquisitive, highly skilled and reflective Instructors, Coaches and Leaders.
- To have strong, collaborative and valued relationships with Delivery Partners, Providers, Instructors, Coaches and Leaders.
- KPI 1 Maintain UK and International satisfaction rates from Instructors, Coaches and Leaders >92%
- **KPI 2** Increase in partners promoting British Canoeing qualifications, awards and services from 2022 baseline
- **KPI 3** Increase digital library users annually by 20% per year from 2021 baseline.
- KP 4 Create blended learning opportunities across all awards by 2025
