Confirmation of Senior Selection Points Scored at the 2023 World Championships & World Cup Final

Course Design Senior Canoe Slalom Team Selection Races:

- The course designers for the selection races this weekend will be drawn on Friday 20th October 2023. Two coaches are responsible for the course design for each phase of selection racing: Races 1 & 2, Races 3,4, and they will be drawn as follows:
 - Draw 1 contains technical coaches from the UK Olympic Podium Programme or substitute approved in advance by the IP.
 - Draw 2 contains employed coaches from Scotland (1), Wales (1) England (1) as well as the UK Academy Programme (2).
- The appointed Chief Judge will be involved directly in the course design proposals. Following the
 course design draw, course designs are to be submitted to the Chief Judge. Course approval takes
 place immediately following demonstration runs. Final pole adjustments are made by the course
 designers (or delegated to the Performance Director) in consultation with the Chief Judge.

Team Announcement

The 2024 Senior Team and any Olympic team nomination announcements will be made at 4pm on Wednesday 25th October on the <u>British Canoeing Website</u> as previously stated.

Due to the significance of the process, the International panel will be providing the opportunity for a personal briefing on the afternoon of Wednesday 25th October ahead of the formal announcement to any athlete that has achieved an individual senior international medal in the 2022 or 2023 season. BC staff will provide more detail directly with those athletes meeting the criteria above.

<u>Advanced Information – Remaining 2024 Policies will be released for consultation shortly:</u>

The International Panel are preparing for public consultation the draft 2024 policies that have yet to be published which include the Junior & U23 Canoe Slalom 2024 policy and the Senior, U23 and Junior Kayak Cross 2024 policies.
