VL2 Men

As a result of suspending the selection of Va'a events due to the weather conditions, there will be one final opportunity for the two eligible athletes who have yet to demonstrate the published performance standard to be selected.

In line with the principles of the policy, Ed Clifton & Stewart Clark will be given three final opportunities on one single day to demonstrate the minimum performance standard. Any of the above athletes who demonstrate one performance inside the published standard will be selected to the 2022 World and European Championship Team.

A date will be agreed following discussion between the athletes involved and the Paracanoe staff.

Canoe Sprint World & European Championship Team Announcement

The International Panel received a significant number of requests for exceptional circumstances in line with section 16 of the published policy. As a result the IP has considered each request and is now communicating its decisions.

In order to comply with the process laid out in the policy (in particular section 12.1 of the policy), only now that the outcome of the exceptional circumstances requests has been determined can the conversations take place with athletes.

The IP therefore regret that as a result, <u>the announcement of the Canoe Sprint Senior World</u> <u>& European Championship teams will be delayed until Friday 10th June at 5pm</u> in order to ensure that the published process is followed.
