



British Canoeing - Canoe Sprint & Paracanoe International Panel Statement Wednesday 7th June 2023

The International Panel would like to start by sincerely thanking the volunteers, officials, Regatta Committee and SRC for creating and delivering another successful National regatta.

Paracanoe World Championships and World Cup 3 selection

The Paracanoe World Championship and World Cup 3 selection is a designated senior team event and is also the 2024 Paralympic qualification event. Up to 2 athletes can be selected per sport class in Paralympic events. As an athlete can only secure one IPC quota slot per nation, the strategy in 8.5.1 will be implemented. The Paracanoe European Championships is a designated development event and the IP considered the nominations based on the need for classification, development needs, and the athletes trajectory, in line with the Paracanoe aims for Paris 2024 and LA 2028. New athletes were required to achieve the outlined development performance standard and existing athletes required to achieve the senior performance standard.

Canoe Sprint Junior and U23 World & European Championship Team Selection

In considering the regatta results and applying the performance standards as per the published policy, the IP determined that the weather conditions for the June regatta were defined as good so no weather corrections were applied to the times outlined in Table B.

Explanation of how the performance standard was applied

Performance standards were decided as per the process outlined in Appendix 1 of the Canoe Sprint Junior Selection Policy 2023 and Canoe Sprint U23 Selection Policy 2023. The performance standard agreed for the Junior World and European Championships, were for boats to be competing to make a B Final level performance or better.

The U23 World Championships and European Championship performance standards were taken from Table B and selection was based on achieving 109% (which is considered the most inclusive end of the performance window). Discussions were had around athletes who achieved 109-110%. For the World Championships, the performance standards have been fully applied. For Europeans, which is more of a development event, there were further discussions and assessment around whether athletes would make B finals.
