Olympic Hopes selection

Olympic Hopes is a key development competition for U17 and U16 athletes within the pathway. Senior World Championships selection (Non - Olympic events)

For the Senior World Championships, key events, which have clear rationale to support Olympic event preparations were highlighted within the selection policy. The below athletes have won the selection races and the IP have sufficient knowledge of performance to support the selections. Please note that no eligible boats entered into the C2 events, therefore no selections have been made. 5K events were being selected from performances either at the European Championships or World Cup 2 in Poznan, however no athletes met the criteria, therefore no selections have been made for the 5k races.
